**Homework:** Homework will be assigned daily in lecture and collected weekly in discussion. It is extremely important to have the homework completed in a timely manner since approximately one half of the quiz problems will come directly from the assigned homework, with the other half being similar to assigned problems.

**Quizzes:** A total of six (6) quizzes will be given throughout the quarter in the discussion sections. Each quiz will be based on the homework which is due that same day. The lowest score will be dropped before the overall quiz score is computed. Students will be given approximately 20 minutes for each quiz. Calculators, notes and books are not allowed during the quizzes, unless provided by the instructor.

**Midterm:** The midterm is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, May 10th, in lecture. The problems will be based on the homework, quizzes and lectures up to that point. Calculators, notes and books are not allowed during the midterm exam, unless provided by the instructor.

**Final:** The final exam will take place on Monday, June 11th, from 7:00pm to 10:00pm. The problems will be based on the homework, quizzes and lectures from the entire course. Calculators, notes and books are not allowed during the final exam, unless provided by the instructor. Please bring your student ID or a driver's license to the exam for identification purposes.
