In my opinion, he should do worksheets or different examples that revolve around the concepts taught in lecture. It would make me gain a better understanding if there were more examples taught after lecture (rather than asking homework questions). He does provide in-depth explanations for each step he does in a problem, using key terms. He is very effective and knows how to clarify any confusion in the course.
- If the class took place in person, there is no doubt that Ryan Ta would perform much better as a teaching assistant. Ryan Ta encourages students to engage and he really tries his best to help his students. He understands the material very well, however, he does get off track at some times by mentioning other material that does not relate to the course.
