

**UPDATED GENERAL INFORMATION — NOVEMBER 30, 2009**

One more point regarding the exam. After going through the exam one more time, I thought it was a little too long for the amount of time allowed for working it, so there will be an adjustment to the grading: Instead of taking 100 to be the cutoff for the highest A (= a normalized score of 4.0), the cutoff for a 4.0 score will be 80; all scores over 80 will be regarded as earning extra credit (in other words, normalized scores greater than 4.0).
