

UPDATED GENERAL INFORMATION — MARCH 14, 2020

Second posting today

During the past day or so there have been several new notifications and explanations from the Riverside County Government, the UCR Higher Administration, the Academic Senate, and the Department of Mathematics which necessitate changes in the submission of final examinations.

It now seems likely that students will NOT be able to access Skye Hall and return examinations as previously planned.

In a previous update I also provided an option for electronic submission, which was not noted implicitly either yesterday or earlier today. Right now *the only workable option seems to be for students to submit electronic copies of their exams.* As indicated in [update14](#), responsibility for submitting a readable electronic copy lies with each student. If this is impossible or causes substantial difficulties, please let me know.

Third quiz scores (more information)

In a previous announcement I stated that students with missing third quiz scores will have the average of the first two quizzes used to figure final grades. For students who do have third quiz scores, this average will also be used if it is greater than the score reported for the third quiz. Hence there is no penalty for taking the third quiz and not doing as well as one did on the previous ones.
