
Map of British India

This map is posted because it depicts the entire area and sheds light on some historical developments. For example, the culture that flourished along the Indus River during the 3rd millennium B.C.E. was comparable to those of Egypt, Mesopotamia and China in terms of its accomplishments, but much of it is not in the modern state of India.
