I regret the delay in finishing the grading of the first exam. With a few exceptions, the raw scores for individuals are now posted on iLearn, and here is the curve for the raw scores:

| Total possible | 100 |
| :--- | :--- |
| Lowest A $=3.0$ | 80 |
| Lowest B = 2.0 | 65 |
| Lowest C = 1.0 | 45 |
| Lowest D = 0.0 | 25 |

The median score was 73. Raw scores between the two cutoff points will be adjusted by linear interpolation. These adjusted scores will be used when computing the final grade. In cases where no score has been recorded, some additional checking is needed, and this should be completed by Tuesday, June 1.
