# UPDATED GENERAL INFORMATION — JUNE 6, 2016

Starting time for the final examination

**IMPORTANT.** As indicated previously, the starting time is 9:00 A.M., and you will have two hours to complete an exam which is 50% longer than the midterm exam. ## A few higher priority items

You should be familiar with the construction of a product atlas for the topological product of two smooth manifolds, the construction of the induced covering space atlas for a (Hausdorff) covering space of a smooth manifold, and the construction of a smooth, real valued proper map on a smooth noncompact manifold. In the first two cases, you should also be familiar with the formal properties of these constructions with respect to smooth mappings such as recognizing when a continuous mapping into such a construction is smooth.

Corrections are needed for Additional Exercise 5.1. First of all throughout the discussion f should be a smooth function into  $\mathbb{R}$  and not  $\mathbb{R}^n$ . Also, the equation for  $\nabla f$  above the displayed formula should read  $\nabla f = -\sum_j \lambda_j \cdot \nabla g_j(x)$ .

#### Numerous low priority items

We shall only list low priority exercises from the last four chapters which are for some reason less important to try or to solve. For Chapter 5, these are 3, 11, 17, 19 in Lee and 2, 5, 9 - 14in the Additional Exercises. For Chapter 6, these are 1, 3 in Lee and the "only if" direction for 2(ii) in the Additional Exercises. For Chapter 7, these are 1, 2, 4, 20, 21, 24 in Lee and 5, 6 in the Additional Exercises. For Chapter 8, these are 1, 11 in Lee and 8, 9 in the Additional Exercises. All exercises in Lee not cited in the exercise files are also low priority.

Going backwards slightly, problems 3.2–3.4 and 4.10–4.15 from the Additional exercises are also low priority, but **none** of the Additional exercises for Chapters 1 and 2 are low priority.
